Dear Sirs,

It has recently come to my notice that Leeds City Council is planning to build houses on the Green Belt sites in Horsforth & Rawdon, i.e. the Leeds Site Allocation Plan. I refer particularly to site HG2-41, where in excess of 777 houses are planned. Surely this contravenes the National Policy for Green Belt Land.

This site (HG2-41) straddles the A65 which already has more traffic on it than is sensible, especially in rush hour. I presume that the planners will allow only one outlet onto the A65, but 777 houses means approximately 1500 cars. Where will all these people work; Sandog has closed and has not been replaced, and so have other small industries in the area.

Another site - HG2-43 already has buildings for education, these buildings should be made into a school, to educate children from the old Sandog site. There would be enough space for playing fields so that the next generation have a chance to be sportsmen, maybe even more BROWNLEE boys. I grew up when St Margaret's church was surrounded by woods & green fields when we

played and watched wild life.

I would like the next generation who live in Mansforth to have a similar opportunity.

So I impore you to think very carefully about the Leeds Core Strategy & do not build on the Green Belts (HG2-41, and HG2-43)
