FIELDS OFF A65, RAWDON

I was very disturbed to read that land adjacent to Knott Lane and to the rear of Layton Lane, Rawdon have been allocated 246 homes. They are all in Green Belt and shown as Strategic Green Infrastructure in Leeds Core Strategy.

The combined use of sites HQ2-41, HQ2-12, HQ3-2 and HQ3-3 given that the intervening space consists only of Rawdon Crematorium would serve to merge Thosforth and Rawdon. This is inconsistent with both the NPPF and

Leeds Core Strategy.

All sites would require access to the A65 which is often referred to as a 'car park' rather than a main road.

The proposal to include these Green Belt sites in the Local Plan is not consistent with the national policy.
