Proposed Housing Development – Site HG2-16 (1002)- Land to rear of 45 Creskeld Lane, Bramhope

I write to object strongly to the above proposed housing development. This objection is based on the following:-

- The ever increasing traffic flow on the A660 and the lack of good public transport, does not allow for any more housing developments in Bramhope.

The majority of traffic on this road is heading into and out of Leeds, with cars coming in from Otley, Ilkley, Bramhope, Adel, Headingley and beyond. This makes travelling into work a long and dangerous journey. Traffic that has built up from all directions currently comes to a standstill all the way round the Lawnswood roundabout, and motorists have to take a gamble as to whether it is safe to move forward or not.

- The facilities in Bramhope do not lend themselves to such a large increase in population, as it is a village. There is one primary school, one doctors surgery, and a few shops. The proposal to build more houses would mean that it would become a town, but it would not have the infrastructure or vital services to support it. The proposal to build on this site, added to the proposals to build houses on a massive scale, on the other sites in Bramhope, would not be therefore be a feasible option.
- The loss of greenbelt would have a very detrimental effect on the conservation area, and the loss of trees and wildlife, would have a very damaging effect on the environment as a whole.
