Dear Sir or Madame,

I wish to voice my objection to the Leeds City Council proposal to build on Greenbelt land in Aireborough. I moved into my first marital home, on Westfield, a newly built estate over forty years ago. Since then more houses have been built on Kirk Lane (factory site), Aireborough Grammar School, Netherfield Road(factory sites), High Royds and Harrogate Road at the top of Yeadon. No new schools have been built, although several have been rebuilt. Only two new NHS surgeries have, to my knowledge, been built.

LCC is now proposing to build on our Greenbelt contrary to National Planning Policy Framework. All the sites HG21/4/5/6/8/10 are areas where me and my children walked past, explored and played. If building goes ahead, where will my grandchildren walk, explore and play? How can this be sustainable?

Aireborough has had more than its share of new houses and is rapidly becoming a dormitory suburb of Leeds, not a place to raise children.

In recent years friends have left the area, citing congestion and poorer quality of life as motivation.

Please reconsider your plans to build more housing in this area.

Not only is the planning a bone of contention. What about the road congestion which is now very bad at times on the A65 despite roundabouts etc. So I cannot see any way this can be changed.
