am writing with great

concern about your proposals to build on greenbelt land in the Rawdon area. The particular sites that concern me are:-

Hg2-12 Woodlands Drive, Rawdon.

Hg3- Fields off A65, Rawdon

Hg22-41 Fields South of A65 near Cemetery

Hg2-43 Fields at Horsforth College Campus

These are all sites that keep green spaces in Rawdon and separate us from nearby towns - Horsforth, Guiseley etc. They provide areas for walking and exercise and general well-being. They also provide habitat for local wildlife and valuable trees to provide oxygen, to counteract the pollution from the nearby busy roads.

I myself live in a new development that was built on a

known factory site - Storey trans-
and have no problem with
developing brownfield locations.
There are several of these around
Lanndon, waiting for interested
parties to give them the go-ahead
for improvement - factories or
green lane, district housing, etc.
Please consider using these sites
before green belt.

Using Green Belt sites IS NOT
consistent with the national policy
and should only be justified when
brownfield has been exhausted.

The proposal to use the Strategic
Green Infrastructure goes against
the Leeds Core Strategy.

I beg you to reconsider the
use of the Green Belt land.
