As part of the Leeds Site Allocation Plan public consultation process, I would like to formally object to the proposed development of the following sites. HQ2-12 (4254). HQ2-41 (4240). HQ2-42 (1016) & HQ2-43 (5009). It is my understanding that the proposed development sites are NOT consistent with the national policy, specifically with regards to green belt Leeds must continue to protect our Green Belt and greenfields. The fields and green belt spaces are important to me because too much of our green spaces have already been lost to development. Our children and grandchildren must be allowed to experience this beautiful land in all its glory and not to see miles of roads and

and hundreds of buildings. Our roads cannot cope as it is even though recent upgrades have been done.

These sites should continue to be part of Leeds 'Strategic Green Infrastructure' as identified in the Adopted Core Strategy.

It is my understanding that the proposed development sites are NOT consistent with the national policy, specifically with regards to infrastructure. Leeds has insufficient policies in place to address the issues that these developments will generate.

Development and infrastructure requirements must be considered side by side. Development of these sites on greenfields will lead to nearby villages being engulfed within the 'Main Urban Area' and they will no longer be separate 'Major Settlements' of their own. Reference, Adopted Core Strategy (Map 3 Settlement Hierarchy)

My concerns include No current plans to solve traffic problems The closed park lane college could be modified into a new senior school as we only have HorsRoth school for our older children. We already have to wait for 1 to 2 weeks for an appointment at the doctors, with more people living here that would be totally unacceptable and dentists

would be similar. The whole impact on the environment would be a nightmare, we are already a car park for Leeds goodness knows what it would be like with hundreds of new houses, our buses trains and cars a woefully inadequate. Please keep me informed of the public examinations submission of the plans and potential outcome of the review as I would like to retain my right to attend and speak.
