There is a very glib reference to using Low Shops Lane as a secondary entrance to the proposed area however this fails to take account of the access to that street via Haighside Drive and Haighside Way. These are minor, estate roads which, I suggest would rapidly become very dangerous 'rat-runs' particularly, as I feel certain, access to the proposed site would be required, though not shown on the plans, from the A639.

We have recently learned that there is an alternative application (Hope Farm) for housing development of a similar size in the Robin Hood Area which would appear to be a better option than that proposed at Haighside. We ask the Council to consider our views, please.
