I wish to object to planning reference HG2 179 Fleet Lane/Eshald Lane 40 units and HG2 180 Fleet Lane/Methley Lane 322 units/two form entry schools.

These lands are green belt so should be protected against development. There is still plenty of brown field sites that should be developed first as well as all the empty houses that are in and around the Leeds area which could be made liveable and more affordable.

These proposed developments would be completely unsustainable and would be completely car dependant leading to more traffic in the area which is already a big issue. The new development already under way on former pas land off Fleet Lane is still not finished yet and we don't know what impact this extra traffic will be bringing – it certainly won't help that's for sure.

If a road was put in linking Fleet Lane and Methley Lane that would be even worse, making a short cut which would create havoc at the end of Fleet lane, which is already a poor junction to get in or out of.

The areas in question are green belt for a reason, they are peaceful and pleasant areas which are used by wildlife and ramblers alike and should be preserved at all costs, especially while there are other options available.
