I have grave objections to Leeds City Council plans for building on Green Belt and Greenfield sites along the A65, by Horsforth roundabout and up to Rawdon Crematorium. Also on conservation areas surrounding the Park Lane College site.

The plans of the Leeds Site Allocation Plans contravene the National Policy Planning Framework (NPPF).

I object to sites HG2-41 (4240)
HG2-42 (1016)
HG2-43 (5009)
HG2-12 (4254)

The NPPF has a whole section dedicated to Green Belt which states that

it is to prevent urban sprawl and
respecting local character and distinctiveness
and maximising opportunities to recycle
previously developed land (PDL), whilst
minimising greenfield & Green Belt release.

I do not object to sites HQZ-37
HQZ-44
HQZ-45
HQZ-46.

I believe the figures for the target of
number of houses to be wrong and out
of date.

Leed also has over 5,500 long-term empty
properties and work is needed to renovate
these. Over 90% which have been empty
for over six months are privately owned.
On Feb. 3rd 2015 MR. GEMMOW said, the Housing
Minister stated in Parliament "urgent housing
needs should not exceed maintaining the Green Belt,
and this is in the N.P.P.F."

Therefore use of Green Belt is inconsistent
with national policy
