Dear Sir/Madam,

I am referring particularly to sites
HG 2-12 HG 3-2 HG 2-41 HG 2-43 HG 3-3 HG 3-4

These sites are all Greenbelt and the decision to
use these before Brownfield should not be
considered.

Leeds City Council say the city needs 70,000
more houses by 2028, but the Office for National
Statistics projection says it needs only 45,000.
This reduction means that no houses need to be
built on Greenbelt land. Brownfield sites are
available elsewhere across Leeds and these should
be developed before Greenbelt land.

All the sites in my heading are along or near
the A65 which is gridlocked at certain times,
despite the traffic lights being installed at
the Horsforth roundabout, and the building of

hundreds of houses, with most houses having two cars would be disastrous.

If the farmland was to be built on, this would harm the natural habitat of many animals and birds. Deer are often seen in fields around these sites, and wild flowers, including our native bluebells would be lost forever.

Therefore the Core Strategy and Site Allocation plan of Leeds City Council is unsound and should be disregarded.
