Dear Councilors,

I am worried and disgusted with the plans to build more new homes, this time on the greenfield sites from Horsforth roundabout to Rawdon crematorium HG2-41. I cannot understand why Green Belts should be used when there are brown field sites to build on.

HG2-42 and HG2-43 should also not be used for building. The roads are not coping with the traffic now and any more houses with more cars would make travelling a nightmare. The traffic lights at Horsforth roundabout have only made it safer to negotiate but not reduced the queues. I had to queue for a mile when coming from Rawdon on the A65 to the roundabout.

In addition to the above, wildlife would also be affected and this should not happen. Apart from anything else NPPF states that Green Belts should only be used in exceptional circumstances, therefore, the above Green Belts should definitely not be taken for housing. Also on the legal side the sites should remain as Green Belts.
