Re: Leeds City Site Allocation Plans.

I am writing in response to the consultation by Leeds City Council who are currently considering increasing 'housing developments' on green belt land around Horsforth & other local sites. I personally disapprove this intention. We are already overwhelmed with newly built housing taking over every bit of spare land & do not have many green belt areas left to enjoy & spend our spare time.

The sites I am particularly concerned about are:-

HG2-41 Fields South of A65 Horsforth Roundabout to the Crematorium

HG²42 Fields at Broadway & Colverley Lane
HG2-13 Fields at Horsforth College Campus
HG2-12 Fields at Woodlands Drive, Rawdon
HG3-2, HG3-3 & HG3-4 Fields off A65 Rawdon

The proposal to include these development sites in the local plan contravenes the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF); also the local roads are already congested with traffic!

My husband, family & I have lived in this region since 1957 & it is absolutely amazing how first one location & then another has been brought up for housing development. ---

I have one suggestion, & that is for the Planning Committee to look beyond the boundaries of Horsforth, Rawdon, Colverley etc. & check the open countryside in order to build a new
'City'

This letter gives me the opportunity to mention - why on earth was St. Joseph's Convalescent Home demolished? The building could have been renovated & kept as a local Convalescent Home after the Nuns vacated the property. I know the land has been up for sale for 'local-builds' but local residents objected & so the grounds are fruitlessly left.

I trust my letter will be taken into consideration when you make your final decisions.
