It has recently come to my attention that the proposed access routes are through Wood Lane & Low Steps Lane. I think that this is a ridiculous idea! Everyone on the Haightside Estate already uses this route & the majority of the time is single width with residents parked cars, this would practically turn a residential road into main road traffic volume! Saw bones traffic is already busy at the best of times.

We have no schools to provide places for the additional families these houses would bring. However I understand that a landowner of Hope Farm has submitted an alternative in Robin Hood that would also provide/include a much needed new primary school. (We could
