Re: Site HG2 – 17 (1080 & 3367A)

As long-term residents of Bramhope we would like to lodge our objections to the potential building of around 400 new homes on a green field site in Bramhope.

It is ethically and environmentally unacceptable to build on green fields/green belt when many brown field and more sustainable sites already exist. Green fields define Bramhope as what it is, a village as opposed to being part of an urban sprawl.

We do not feel that existing facilities in Bramhope such as the health centre would be able to cope with a large increase in population. Our existing bus service is not as frequent as it could be and we wonder what might happen with a lot more people living in the village and competing for local services.

Also we have concerns for the traffic flow on the main Leeds road. It is already very busy and we have heard that an estimated 800 more cars might be trying to use the same road at peak times if the proposed new houses are built. This would only increase congestion and pollution.

We do hope that you will take the above comments into account and that permission to build all these extra houses will not be granted.
