Dear Sir/Madam,

I would like to object to the following proposed building sites:

HG2-41, HG2-42, HG2-43, HG2-12, HG3-2.

To build on these greenfield sites would be in direct conflict with national policy which states clearly that no greenbelt is to be built on unless there are exceptional circumstances and housing is not one of them. These sites must be preserved to prevent urban sprawl and the essence of the local historic towns. Leeds City Council has used only a fraction of brownfield sites across Leeds for building and must be stopped from destroying beautiful greenbelt which in turn destroys the wildlife that thrive in these areas. This over development in Leeds is NOT what the people want and if the Localism Act is to mean anything then Leeds City Council should listen to the people. Also I have not seen or heard any information about these proposals from LCC, I have only become aware of them through the grapevine.
