I am particularly concerned about the following sites —

H42-12 Woodlands Drive, Rawdon

H43-2, H43; H44 fields off A65, Rawdon.

H42-41 fields south of A65, Horsforth roundabout to the hematorium

H42-43 fields at Horsforth college campus

These green Belt sites in the local plan is not consistent with national policy.

It is not justified to use green Belt sites before brownfield sites or greenfield sites

This is also against Leeds Core Strategy
