I am responding to the latest site allocation plans and I am objecting on the basis that the plans to build on the green belt contravene the National Planning Policy Framework (NPPF).

HG2 – 41

I am objecting to this site because the additional 777 homes will directly impinge on an already excessively busy road network in and around Horsforth. I have seen a marked increase in the number of cars/lorries using Rawdon/West End Lane as a "rat-run". I believe this will only get worse when the full impact of the traffic from the new Redrow/Clariant site becomes evident.

HG2-12, HG3-2, 3 and 4

I am objecting to the above developments as again these will have a huge impact on an already traffic-heavy road network. We will lose green space with its wildlife habitats and will also lose the definition between Rawdon and Horsforth as these will merge into one.

We all know why people would like to live in Horsforth and Rawdon with its farmer's market and village atmosphere but this development is unsustainable and I feel it would be irresponsible if allowed to go ahead.

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Leeds City Council does not need to build 70,000 new homes based on the revised ONS projections.

I do hope that you will seriously review all the letters of objection you receive and carefully consider the impact these developments will have on the local infrastructure and its residents.
