As part of the Leeds Site Allocation Plan public consultation process I am writing to you, I would like to make a formal objection to the proposed developments on the following sites which are in Horsforth.

H92-41 (4240) - fields south of the A65 Roundabout to Rawdon Crematorium (including the Strabon fields).

H92-42 (1016) - fields at Broadway and Calverley Lane, Horsforth.

H92-43 (5009) - conservation area at Park Lane College Campus Horsforth.

H92-12 (4254) - fields at Woodlands Drive.

I am objecting because we must save our green belt and green field sites for wildlife, conservation, for our children & future generations, as well as for our own health & well being.

Decisions made now ^{to build} ~~will~~ ^{will} destroy our environment and goes against government policies on green belt.

The council & planners must listen & act upon the views of local people.

We have already had hundreds of

PTO-

houses built on the Sendor site & hundreds more planned on the Kirk stall forge site. We do not want any more.

I am also objecting to these developments & plans for Horsforth because of the dangerous congestion and bottlenecks which will be worsened by hundreds of cars which will come on to the roads from the suggested sites.

Apart from the standstill & gridlock that will be a result of this,

there will be a massive increase in pollution levels which are already problematic in Leeds.

In addition I am also very concerned that there are not enough services available to provide for a massive increase in population in Horsforth. The services we have are already over-subscribed.

So I say no & object strongly to any further development in Horsforth.

Please keep me informed of the plans & submissions & the potential outcome of the renewal as I would like to retain my right to attend & speak.
