Site Allocation Consultation

I am writing to express my concerns regarding the sites included in the plans for housing in this area.

In particular, I am concerned about the proposed use of green belt sites in Rawdon HG2-12, HG3-2,3,4 and the proposed use of fields between the Harforth roundabout and Rawdon Crematorium, HG41.

I feel the proposal to use Green Belt before brownfield sites is not justified and will drastically affect the whole character of the area.

I have lived in Rawdon for over 30 years and have seen local roads become progressively busier and gridlocked at certain times of the day and weekends.

The Apperley Lane and Middlefield Lane part of Rawdon is also affected by current and proposed developments in the Bradford area which will add to the congestion on our roads and affect the daily lives and wellbeing of those of us living in the area.
