I write to register my objection to the planning application for sites listed below:

HG2 – 15 (3400) Green Acres and Equestrian Centre

HG2 – 16 (1002) Creskeld Lane, Bramhope – land to rear of no. 45

HG2 – 17 (1080-3367A) Breary Lane East, Bramhope, LS16.

The A660 is not adequate enough to deal with the current congestion never mind increasing the village by 25% and adding to this problem. Villagers leaving on the Cedars have difficulty as it is turning out onto the main road and can sit for ages. It would be near on impossible if you were the increase the size of the village by such a large scale.

There is not enough infrastructure in place to cope with the scale of development proposed and new schools, doctors, etc would need to be built so instead of increasing the size of the village by 25% it would be much more.

To build on green belt and green field sites when there is plenty of brown sites left makes a mockery of the whole system for having these color coded sites.

Bramhope has been placed in a Conservation Area and again going ahead with the development of this size makes a complete mockery of the term Conservation Area. The LCC has turned down planning proposals for various reasons siting that it wouldn't be in keeping with the Conservation Area yet to score the site HG2-16 (1002) Creskeld Lane 13 out of 15 you have to wonder what is going on there!

Because of the reasons stated I would please ask that you oppose this application.
