Green Belt must be sustained for us all, and future generations. If it is built on, there is no going back. I believe the Council's proposals regarding the above enumerated sites in the LDP is not in tandem with H.M. Government national policy. For example, HG2-41 is an area which separates Roundel from Honyfortt, and this position needs to be maintained. The proposed allocation of all these sites for building houses adds up, if I have counted your figures correctly, to 1,497.

Honyfortt is already suffering from too much pressure on its infrastructure. We are desperate,

short on school places and medical facilities. More parking space is urgently required for Hornfort Station, and so on and so on.

I have fears about the environmental effect these proposals will have on the area. These areas are beneficial to the general health, exercise and enjoyment of us all. They are also rich in wild life and bird life, and therefore need protecting.

In summary, I think these plans cannot be supported or justified, since they rely too much on building on Green Belt. I believe also, that there is a conflict with both government national policy and the Council's own policy. I oppose them strongly.
