RE: Building Plans for Horsforth and Rawdon Greenbelt

I am writing to strongly object to the proposals to build on greenbelt and greenfield sites around Horsforth and Rawdon.

Greenbelt sites were originally formed specifically to prevent building taking place on them and once they are lost they are gone forever.

I am particularly concerned about the large development planned for HG2-41 for 777 houses and a school on a piece of land which clearly separates Rawdon from Horsforth as well as plans to build the proposed airport link through the greenfields along with more houses behind Layton Lane.

Please recognise that these fields are not only used for farming but also used by many walkers.

I know you will be aware of the objections being raised by local residents and wish to add my name to the many people who are extremely concerned about losing such valuable green fields in this area.
