I am writing to you to protest against the proposals to build on Greenbelt land in Rawdon and Horsforth. If this planning happens we must realise that we can not undo it. I am particularly concerned about these sites:

- 1) HG2 – **12 Fields** at Woodlands Drive, Rawdon
- 2) HG3 – 2, HG3 – 3, HG3 – **4 Fields** South of A65, Rawdon
- 3) HG2 – **41 Fields** South of A65, Horsforth roundabout to Rawdon Crematorium
- 4) HG2 – **43 Fields** at Horsforth Collage Campus

If these ideas go forward, in number 3 of above, especially children, but adults too, will no longer be able to pick the yummy strawberries and scrumptious asparagus! Also, following this subject, the Horsforth roundabout is busy enough as it is! This would just cause an even bigger delay for people to get to work and school.

Some of the sites (listed above) have old woodland on their grounds, some of which been there for many years. It is very important that we do not lose/cut this down.

Currently, Rawdon and Horsforth are very clearly separated. However, if Councils plans are passed, Rawdon and Horsforth will be merged together, which goes against the National Policy which states that this should not occur.

I know that me and my friends LOVE to cycle and walk around our local community. However, the roads that will have to be built and the extra cars we will have will prevent this from us. I don't find this right or fair!

Lastly, the Council plans to build LOADS of extra houses, but the statistics are unfortunately wrong according to figures from the ONS. Please look again at your numbers! If these are corrected, you will no longer have to build on Greenbelt, but will be able to build on brownfield – which is much better!
