This is an inappropriate development site.

Loss of green belt to green fields then to building sites is already happening in Bramhope!

Golden Acre Park will soon become deplete of the wild life flying and roaming in from the green adjacent areas. Building 376 houses, a school and shop on 19.32 hectares could not mingle in with conservation ideals of a Bramhope Conservation Area.

Water drainage on old marsh land would be problematic for the A660. This road is already overloaded with King Lane as a rat run in commuter rush times. Tail backs already exist at the roundabout.

Access to the site using the A660 would be difficult for pedestrians without suitable crossings which would delay traffic more. Existing houses are already having difficulty getting onto the road.

Bramhope is a friendly community where older people want to stay. Any plans for their future homing and welfare should be a high priority in all future plans.

The Birches still do not have street lights nor is the snow cleared from their roads! How can this proposed urban sprawl opposite them benefit from all the other inconveniences?
