Dear Council,

I wish to protest about the continuing erosion of the green belt around Horsforth, and in particular the proposed plans to build yet more houses around the A65 and A6120 (HG2-41), (HG2-43) and (HG2-42). This area already suffers from massive congestion especially in the rush hour which the new roundabout has done little to alleviate. With more than 1800 more houses planned for, two cars each house, the situation can only get much worse. Horsforth has already been drawn into the Leeds Urban Sprawl and will lose its unique

identity as a village on the outskirts of
Leeds, but rather become part of a
conurbation. The joy of Horsforth is the
easy access to fields and woods etc which
are so important to the community. I
realise that we need houses, but please
look for brownfield sites not lovely green
areas,
