Green Belt Development

We would like to object to the extent of the Green Belt Development proposed in Horsforth and Rawdon in particular the sites...

The proposal to include these Green Belt sites in the Local Plan is NOT consistent with the national policy.

As well as objecting to such a vast area of potential housing it is already clear even before Horsforth Vale is completed (a brownfield site) that the 'improvements'

to Horsforth Roundabout on the ring road are not coping with existing levels of traffic. Further development would mean Horsforth's roads would be effectively 'grid locked'.

We feel strongly that all brown field sites should be fully utilised before any green belt is taken for housing development. The proposal to use Green Belt before brownfield is not justified.

The areas of Green Belt around Horsforth and Rawdon are extremely important to our family as it is used by us to keep healthy, for exercise and generally makes us feel better seeing and using the green space around us.

The proposal to use this Strategic Green Infrastructure goes against the Leeds Core Strategy.
