Dear Sirs

I am writing about your proposals to build hundreds of houses on greenbelt land in Rawdon. Green belt land is so called for a reason – to keep area between villages and towns green and open. Proposals to build on this land is not consistent with national policy.

I am particularly concerned about the combined use of sites HG2-41, HG2-12, HG3-2 and HG3-3, given that the intervening space consists only of Rawdon Crematorium, would mean that Horsforth and Rawdon would merge.

Building 130 houses on site HG3-4 Layton Lane and fields in HG3-2 and HG3-3 would also increase traffic on the already congested A65 as well as destroying green areas and wildlife.

I note that HG2-41 is to include a new school but I cannot see any mention of what extra facilities are to be provided for all these proposed new houses in Rawdon, ie schools, doctor's surgeries or dentists.

I am asking you not to build in these green fields but consider alternative brownfield sites.
