DEAR SIRS

I WISH TO OBJECT TO THE ABOVE PLANS ON THE BASIS THAT THESE AREN'T CONSISTENT WITH NEEDS OWN CORE PLAN OR NATIONAL POLICY ON GREEN BELT SITES. THE COUNCIL'S OWN CORE STRATEGY PLAN IN ITS GLOSSARY DEFINES GREEN BELT AS A DESIGNATION FOR AREAS OF OPEN LAND AROUND CERTAIN CITIES AND LARGE BUILT UP AREAS WHERE STRICT PLANNING CONTROLS APPLY TO KEEP THE LAND PERMANENTLY OPEN AND LARGELY UNDEVELOPED.

THE NATIONAL PLANNING POLICY FRAMEWORK STATES THAT THE GOVERNMENT ATTACHES GREAT IMPORTANCE TO GREEN BELTS. THE FUNDAMENTAL AIM OF GREEN BELT POLICY IS TO PREVENT URBAN SPRAWL BY KEEPING LAND PERMANENTLY OPEN. THE ESSENTIAL CHARACTERISTICS OF GREEN BELTS ARE THEIR OPENNESS AND THEIR PERMANENCE.

THERE HAS ALSO BEEN LITTLE CONSULTATION BY THE CITY COUNCIL. THE ONLY INFORMATION COMING FROM LOCAL COUNCILLORS USING THEIR OWN INITIATIVE.

THE COLLEGE MENTIONED THAT PART OF THEIR CAMPUS WAS A NATURE RESERVE.

BECAUSE OF THIS LACK OF CONSULTATION AND THE ABOVE  
I DONT BELIEVE THAT EITHER OF THESE SITES ARE  
JUSTIFIED NOR SOUND NOR EFFECTIVE AND CERTAINLY  
NOT NECESSARY.
