Dear Sir or Madam

I am writing to you with my concerns regarding your proposed building developments in the following sites:-

- 1) HG2 - 41 Fields South of ABS Horsforth roundabout to the crematorium.
- 2) HG2-43 Fields at Horsforth College Campus.
- 3) HG2-12 Fields at Woodlands Drive, Rawdon.
- 4) HG3-2, HG3-3, HG3-4 Fields at ABS Rawdon.

I feel that the Horsforth area is being unfairly targeted for a good proportion of New Housing in Leeds. The lovely areas earmarked for these developments are areas which are important to me and my family and many other people like us for our wellbeing, health and exercise.

Your proposal to include these Green Belt sites in your plans are not consistent with the national policy. Green Belt sites should NOT be used before brownfield sites, this is NOT justified, and your proposal to use the Strategic Green Infrastructure goes against the Leeds Core Strategy.

There is a significant amount of building going on in the Horsforth Area at the moment. This has a knock on effect to all the people who live in Horsforth now. We have road congestion, schools can't cope, it is difficult to get a doctors or dentists appointment as the population has increased in this area and all these services can't cope with this new demand. Any further developments will cause massive problems to Horsforth.

I moved to Horsforth in 1984 because I loved the area and great open spaces. I have seen many changes in this time and the Horsforth I knew and loved is disappearing before my eyes.

I have never complained about any new building development in the past, but on this occasion I feel that I have to, hopefully you will take my concerns on board and leave what is left of the fields and open spaces in Horsforth alone, and look at other areas in Leeds for your building developments
