I strongly object to planning ref H62-50 being allocated for more housing. Church Ln. Paddock has shrunk from the original size with building at the top end. To lose the last green meadow in Meanwood not only causes severe damage to the setting of the church & damage to the character & heritage of Meanwood, but the health of the community. It should be a wildlife habitat & orchard with a pond, like ~~it~~ used to ~~have~~ many years ago. More hard surfaces will add to more severe flooding <sup>there</sup> further down because the main drain was built in the sixties when runoff wasn't anywhere near it is now. I've lived next to the beck for 46 yrs. so I know it ~~isn't in~~ ~~spice~~ floods more frequent.
