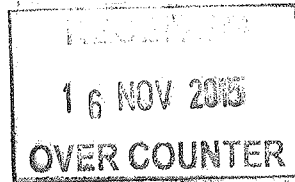

I am against these greenbelt areas being handed over to developers for housing.
