Sites HG2-170 (41 Units) H.M.R. Reservoir, HG2-171 (189 Units) Westerton Rd Reservoir,  
Also HG2-167 (619 Units) Thorpe Lane, 13/05423 (299 Units) Adjacent Amblers Mill

I wish to object to the above planned housing sites in the Tingley, West & East Ardsley areas for the following reasons.

1. HG2-170 -H.M.R. Res. Development on this site has already been rejected by the Planning Inspectorate for 10 houses, to build 41 is obviously in breach of her decision.
2. HG2-171 – Westerton Res. The junction of H.M.Road and Westerton Rd. has become a dangerous bottleneck due to on street parking, Cllr. Dunn has promised to investigate. The extra traffic created will exasperate the problem.
3. The building of the above 2 sites will spoil the area around the reservoir which is a major attraction for visitors and walkers.
4. The local area infrastructure cannot support the existing population, the schools are full, the local health centre and pharmacy are stretched to the limit. The local bus services are poor, as mentioned in your previous reports. The building of 600 houses, including the Haigh Wood proposals, together with a further 918 houses on Thorpe Lane and Ambler Mill will render this area unsustainable.

I believe that the plans fail on Ecology, Conservation , Highways/transport,  
Local services/facilities, Loss of Greenbelt and Schools.
